



Code of Conduct

All participants, students and parents alike, are to treat others with courtesy and respect at all times. We respect each other in our:

- **SPEECH**

Our goals are to help each other in our journey of homeschooling, to support one another, to be a blessing in the lives of each other. Arrows does not desire to facilitate a place for “hot button” discussions or conversations of a divisive nature. Inappropriate conversations, gestures, foul language or aggressive physical contact will not be permitted and may be grounds for termination of membership.

- **DRESS**

We seek to honor God in both character and dress. We request modesty and discretion over making a ‘statement’ with our clothing, makeup, and jewelry. No visible underclothing, bare midriff or cleavage is allowed. Shirts and shoes are required at all times.

- **CONDUCT**

Members may not bring weapons (real or play), laser pointers, illegal drugs, alcohol or cigarettes on the premises. Arrows is a smoke-free campus (no smoking in or on the property). No roller shoes (such as Heely’s), bikes, skateboards, scooters or rollerblades are allowed on the premises. Toys are to be left at home, unless required for class. Except in the case of working service dogs, advance approval is required before bringing animals/insects/etc. (including pets) onto the premises.

If your child becomes unruly or is distracting from an instructional time on campus or at an Arrows field trip/event, please remove your child from the group until control is regained.
